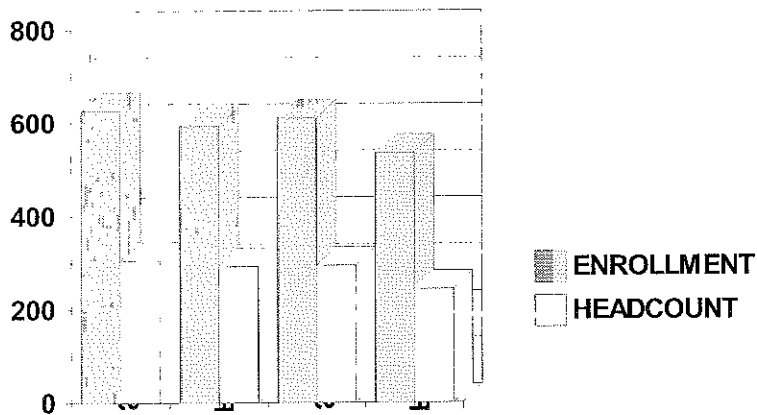

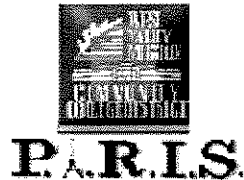

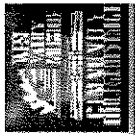

Notes : "Total Grades" is the total number of grades awarded (A, B, C, D, F, I, CR, NC, or W) to students in a given group (e.g., total, ethnic, gender, or age group).

"Success Rate" is the total number of A, B, C, & CR awarded divided by "Total Grades". To derive the number of success grades awarded, multiply the value in "Total Grades" by the decimal version of the percentage shown in "Success Rate" (e.g., 68.2% means that you will multiply total grades of, say, 1,500 by 0.682 to arrive at 1,023 success grades awarded).
