Temporary Campus Center Closure 9/9/2025

Dear Campus Community,

West Valley-Mission Community College District will host a special event on Tuesday, September 9 at West Valley College's Campus Center to celebrate the launch of the District's Free Meal Plan and the grand opening of the Oak Bistro.

To prepare for this event and ensure a safe, welcoming environment for guests, the **Oak Bistro**, cafeteria seating area and coffee shop will be closed from 11 a.m.-5 p.m. on Tuesday, September 9. The Thomas-To-Go App will not be available during these times.

- **Grab-and-go breakfast** will be available from 8-10:30 a.m. (to-go only; indoor seating is unavailable).
- Vending machines in the Language Arts and Social Science, Cilker and Science and Math buildings will remain open for additional food options. View a map of vending machine locations.
- Free pizza for students will be provided by the Office of Student Needs 11:30 a.m.-2 p.m. in the Basic Needs Area (next to Café Vasona Lounge).
- Two food trucks will also be available on campus for meal purchases:
 - 3 Hermanos Mexican Grill will be stationed along North Walk, across from the Cilker Building.
 - Saigon Street Food will be stationed by the Administration Building lawn, across from the Kirkorian Pavilion.

The Campus Center Lounge (near pool table), Identity Centers and Café Vasona Lounge (former bookstore) will remain open for use throughout the day.

We understand this adjustment may temporarily affect your routine, and we sincerely appreciate your patience and support as we celebrate this important step in expanding resources for our students.
